**Kingston Regional Sports & Entertainment Centre Announces Partnership with Tickets.com
as the Engine to Distribute Event Tickets**

Kingston's newest entertainment venue has announced how tickets will be made available for its events. The Kingston Regional Sports & Entertainment Centre announced today a partnership with Tickets.com that will see an industry leader provide the engine for ticket distribution for all Centre events, including Kingston Frontenacs games. The Centre will make tickets available through a variety of channels including its website www.kingstonrsec.com, through telephone sales and, eventually, through an on-site ticket office. The ticket system will go live this week to support sales for the Centre's first concert, An Evening With The Tragically Hip scheduled for February 23, 2008.

Guests of the Centre will have the ability to buy tickets online, print the receipt at home, and present the ticket at the door for entry via a barcode scanner. Although the technology is new for a Kingston venue, it has been in practice for a few years in big-league arenas. "Online sales now comprise of over 70% of the live event industry's total ticket sales " says Neil Shorthouse of venue manager Arcturus SMG. "Tickets.com has the claim of the first ticketing company to enable print-at-home tickets and they were also the first to deliver tickets to mobile phones in Europe and the US via an MMS or picture message. Although the technology is not yet available in Canada, the fact that it may become available to us makes for one of the reasons that Tickets.com is an exciting partner for us. We believe that the ticket delivery channels and methods that Tickets.com offers to us will be a big part of our delivery of an exceptional fan experience".

Tickets.com has set up a dedicated call centre for Kingston RSEC events - 877-KLIVE99 (or, 877-554-8399) - that will enable ticket purchasers throughout Canada and the US to access tickets toll free. "Tickets.com also has an established network of outlets in Upstate New York including Price Chopper stores in Watertown and Ogdensburg which gives us important exposure on the south side of the border" says Shorthouse. Local outlets are in the process of being established. "We have been on a very aggressive implementation schedule to get tickets for some of our events on sale prior to Christmas. Obviously our ticket office has not been fully constructed, but we are working to get it and some satellite outlets up and functional as soon as possible for in-person sales."
